<p>Excerpt Autostated verbatim</p> <p style="text-align: center;">SECRET SECURITY INFORMATION</p> <p>At the intervention of Leon Neguzzi, the American Cathedral of Paris was placed at the disposal of the Veterans for the Christmas Services. This is the second occasion which took on a semi-official character in establishing collaboration between America and the Rumanian organization in Paris. The first came through collaboration with the Paris Branch of the American Legion. It was Mrs. Marjorie Negruzzi, born Davenport, who obtained cooperation from the American, Denby Wilkes. The Christmas Service in the Cathedral was conducted by the Orthodox Bishop Visarion Puiu. The latter, according to his own statement, was sent from Rome to Paris by Cardinal Tisserand.
