To C/GI/R&A:

1. After you left the RARG meeting on 24 August 1965, there was further discussion of the RIS program. [] is still much concerned over our input to the program, and feels there has been a lack of coordination at his level. In other words, SR/GI has not been aware of the general division of duties between SR and CI Staff. I replied that coordination between [] SR/RMO, and CI/MRO had been close and continuing, and that I assumed that there had also been an understanding at the [] level. [] agreed that there might well have been, and that [] may have reached a similar understanding. I assured [] that we were still ready to discuss the matter of overt input at any time, that it would be useful to examine criteria and quite possibly tighten them up, and that we awaited his call.

2. [] made several suggestions for a committee to examine priorities and criteria. I said that this problem was limited to the RIS Machine Program, and to SR and CI, and that we did not want or need any formal mechanism to effect coordination between us.

3. I think we should take the initiative before we lose it. Therefore I suggest that you call [], and the two of you (and I, if it would be helpful) examine the problem. []'s attitude towards the RIS Machine Program has become much more positive during the past several weeks, and he no longer seems antagonistic towards CI Staff. His views, based on his recent study of the RIS Machine Program, should be useful to all of us--including [], [], [], and the contract inputters.
