SUBJECT: Status Report on OVERT Printout

1. It had been hoped that the printout of overt material from the RIS Machine Program could be passed, without further work, to a number of US and liaison services. This did not prove feasible--there simply were too many errors, both human and machine, to allow this. Thus the entire printout (4 volumes, 3,113 pages) has had to be reviewed, and input forms prepared to correct the more flagrant mistakes. The most serious errors resulted from transposition of numbers within arbitrary numbers, which resulted in mixing information on two people in a single summary.

2. Status of the review is as follows:

- (a) 1275 pages reviewed and corrections prepared (roughly 100 input forms).
- (b) an additional 1508 pages reviewed, but corrections not yet prepared (may run to roughly 200 input forms).

3. Schedule for completion of the review, correction, printout, and binding is as follows:

- (a) complete initial review of all 3113 pages --
18 May
- (b) complete preparation of corrections --
24 May
- (c) keypunch ca. 300 input forms, update master tape (IBM 1410 computer) -- 25 May

- (d) print 24 copies of 4 volume sets (IBM 360 computer) -- 26, 27 May
- (e) remove carbon paper from ca. 75,000 pages, and bind 96 volumes -- 26, 27 May, plus weekend overtime, 31 May.
- (f) complete first run of 6 sets -- 31 May
- (g) complete all 24 sets -- 1 June.
