MEMORANDUM FOR: Acting Chief, EE Division

SUBJECT: Resettlement of Sven TREUHOFF Under
the Provisions of Public Law 203
(Refugee Relief Act)

1. Reference is made to your memorandum of 28 March 1955, concerning entry of subject into the United States for permanent residence under the provisions of Public Law 203 (Refugee Relief Act). In accordance with previous arrangements, upon completion of favorable security determination, a nominal sponsor will be furnished to the Alien Affairs Office. This office is prepared to assume primary responsibility for subject upon his arrival in the United States.
2. We have been advised by the Chief, Defector Branch, EE Division, that the only known commitments made to subject were that, if he were successfully immigrated, he would be met upon arrival and would be given assistance in finding suitable employment and housing. We are prepared to assume those commitments. In the event subject makes representations after his entry that authorized officials of this Agency have promised him financial support in excess of the presently known commitments, we shall, of course, take the matter up with your Division and if it is determined that there is a valid additional obligation, it may be necessary for us to call upon your Division for financial support.
