PERTINENT INFORMATION <p>Nicolae Petra once said that he was the one who suggested to Reverend John Trutza that Trutza should bring Viorell Trifa to the United States. During this conversation Petra mentioned to the Informant that Trifa was a member of the Rumanian Iron Guard. Petra also claimed to be a member of the Rumanian Iron Guard and stated that Trifa was important in the Iron Guard Movement in Rumania. Petra claimed that Trifa's expenses to the United States were paid by Reverend John Trutza out of the funds of the St. Mary's Rumanian Orthodox Church and that this action on Reverend Trutza's part was taken without consulting the parishioners of the church.</p>
