Re: Dumitru Stancu
Internal Security - Rumania

A confidential informant who has furnished reliable information in the past has advised that on January 15, 1963, he met with Dumitru Stancu in Washington, D.C.

Stancu stated the Rumanian Government was currently holding frequent conversations with the United States Department of State regarding a renewal of a Cultural Exchange Program.

The Rumanians have been expecting that the United States would present a list of names of persons whose release from Rumania is desired. Stancu commented no such list had been presented.

Stancu requested the informant to note and report the opinions of acquaintances employed by Radio Free Europe.

[DUMITRU] Stancu, apparently, in an inadvertant remark revealed an interest in and probable contact with one Ion [redacted] of New York.

[DUMITRU] Stancu requested the source to attempt to copy of a report submitted by Mr. Constantin Viscol (President of the Rumanian National Committee) to a Senate Committee regarding conditions in Rumania.

Stancu asked the source to ascertain the identity of an American who allegedly left a meeting of the Assembly of Captive European Nations, in disgust. He also desires to know the reason this person left the meeting.
