3. DALOSC, aka Josef DALOS (all traces under DALOS): *

RTI 1734, dated 3 August 1951 - Josef DALOS, Hungarian businessman arrived in Istanbul from Rome on 16 June 1951 and departed for Tel Aviv on 29 June 1951.

PIR 11675, dated 10 October 1951 - Josef DALOS, diplomatic courier, passport No. 100410/ZXm, coming from Prague, arrived at the Ciampino Airport on 13 June 1951. On 8 July 1951, he again arrived at the Ciampino Airport coming from Lydda and on 12 July 1951, he departed from the same airport for Prague.

EAV 694, dated 17 June 1953 - Hungarian, b. 22 August 1923 in Vienna, lives in Budapest, bookkeeper, Austrian visa issued by Austrian Consulate in Teheran valid from 18 May to 18 August 1953, was at Hotel Maencherhof in Vienna on 24 May 1953.

4. Imre FREUND:

WELA 4664 - Debriefing of the Hungarian minister to Scandinavia who defected in July 1950: "I have strong suspicions of Imre FREUND being an agent of AVH if only of a transitory character. He is an engineer delegated by the Hungarian Standard Electric Company to the Svenska Orion Plant at Soedertaelje, owned by the Hungarian Trust. Although he had a wife and child at home - i.e. in Hungary - he worked in the Swedish Plant almost uninterruptedly for almost a full year. On one occasion he asked for our advice and help - i.e. at the Hungarian Legation in Stockholm - to gather confidential information against another engineer at the plant, a certain DAHLGREN. Subject returned to Hungary in December 1949".

OWD 143, 23 June 1953, B-2 - b. 18 Dec 11, agent for Elektroimpex, Budapest, arrived in Norway from Budapest 1 March 1953 to visit some firms, departed 22 March 1953.

EHBA 178, 26 June 1953, Hungarian, born in Budapest 18 December 1911, director of the enterprise Elektroimpex, present address Budapest Furst Sandor u 28, Passport No. 107757, going to Frankfurt/M for negotiations relating to South American and West European business affairs with the firm Bickenbach & Co., Frankfurt/M, Westendstr 70. Duration of stay, one month. Proposed date of departure as soon as possible. Travel by air.

9 July 1953, trace - about to make a trip to West Germany with HEGEDUS for Elektroimpex and Ferunion.

5. HEGEDUES, aka HEGEDUS, Gyorgy (traces under HEGEDUS), b. 1 Jan 18, Budapest:

WSS 369, 8 April 1949, emissary from Hungarian foreign office visiting Hungarian legation in Sweden, suspected secret service inspector. Summary of travels:

- 13 Mar 50 - arrived Cairo from Budapest, representative of heavy industry in Hungary
- 16 Mar 50 - departed Rome for Prague, Passport 17280
- 4 May 50 - departed Rome for Prague, diplomatic or courier duty
- 8 Jun 50 - departed Rome for Prague, Hungarian passport No. 1029

- 10 Jul 50 - visa granted "to go to Merrem en la Porte, Herengacht 473, Adam"
- 4 Sep 50 - arrived Rome from Prague, en route to Bari
- 25 Mar 51 - arrived Rome from Prague

- 23 Mar 52 - departed Cairo for Istanbul
- 12 May 52 - departed Istanbul for Beirut
- 6 Sep 52 - arrived Lebanon, Hungarian passport No. 16980, issued Budapest 30 June 1952.
- 7 Sep 52 - departed Lebanon for Cairo
- 15 Jan 53 - arrived Lebanon, 19 Jan 53 departed for Teheran
- 24 Feb 53 - arrived Rome; Hungarian section chief, passport 16980.

ESBA 178, 26 June 1953 - director of the enterprise FERUNION. Hungarian, born 1 August 1918, Budapest, present address Budapest Furst Sandor u 33. Passport No. 101733. Going to Frankfurt/M for negotiations relating to South America and West European business affairs with the firm Bickenbach & Co., Frankfurt/M Westendstr 70. Duration of stay - one month. Proposed date of departure - as soon as possible. Travel by air.

9 July 1953 - making trip to West Germany with Imre FREUND for Elektroimpex and FERUNION.

Possible traces: 25 October 1950, a report from Trieste stated that a George HEGEDUS, born Jan 1918, was among a group of Hungarian refugees in Trieste expressing their desire to return to Hungary under the Hungarian Amnesty Grant.

SZABAD NEP carries a story of sentence of dismissal and exclusion from trade union passed by Worker's Court on Gyorgy HEGEDUS former technical director Hungarian rubber goods factory. ODACID, 20 March 1951.
