SUBJECT : Operation HENNE

1. We have at last found some traces of "DALOSC", in the form of traces of travels of a Hungarian named Josef DALOS, who is apparently identical with the person we are interested in:

- a. Josef DALOS, Hungarian businessman, arrived in ISTANBUL from ROME 16 June 1951, departed for TEL AVIV 29 June 1951.
- b. Josef DALOS, diplomatic courier, passport number 100410/ZXm, arrived in ROME by air from PRAGUE 13 June 1951. On 8 July 1951 he returned to ROME (after making the trips noted in sub-paragraph a. above) by air from LYDDA, and departed for PRAGUE on 12 July 1951.
- c. A Josef DALOS, born 22 August 1923 in VIENNA, Hungarian citizen, residing in BUDAPEST, bookkeeper, was issued an Austrian visa by the Austrian Consulate in TEHERAN valid from 18 May to 18 August 1953, and was registered in the Hotel Muenchnerhof in VIENNA on 24 May 1953. (N.B. - this may not be the same man as the man in sub-paragraphs a. and b.)

2. We have also received the somewhat laconic statement that Imre FREUND and Gyorgy HEGEDUS are both suspected of being operatives of the Hungarian intelligence service. We have no further information on this, but presume the statement is based on something more than pure suspicion.
