SUMMARY Inclosure 1 is a copy of the book "The Next World War" (次世大戦争) by Masanobu TSUJI. Inclosure 2 is a translation of the Preface and Table of Contents of this book. The book explains the substance of TSUJI's views on the position Japan should take in the world today in order to preserve the country from destruction in the next war. COMMENT: TSUJI, a very vocal Liberal-Democratic Diet member and ex-army officer, has considerable influence in Japan today. His views are neutralist and anti-American as well as anti-Communist. The position he has taken in this book conforms to the ideas he expounded in his lecture to officers of this office reported in R-11-56.
