MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Meeting with AECAMBISTA 16 on 17 March 1955

1. Subject was contacted in New York City for the regular monthly meeting. Discussion was limited to a general appraisal of the study draft notes which had been submitted by AECAMBISTA 16. He was told that his contract had been extended for another 6 months, subject to the same conditions as in the initial contract. Therefore, if the study is deemed satisfactory, the contract should run through 31 September 1955. AECAMBISTA 16 has completed an outline for the study.

2. The income tax withheld for the January and February 1955 pay periods was returned to AECAMBISTA 16. Subject submitted his accounting for \$10.33 to be charged against the \$27.15 outstanding balance of the \$150.00 advance for operational expenses. This outstanding balance was returned in cash and the \$150.00 advance has now been fully accounted.

3. Subject was given copies of several Soviet publications per his request. Generally, he has observed in the past, that although there have been no specific references made to Radio Liberation as such, there is an indication in the Soviet press that this radio is having some effect on Soviet propaganda. According to Subject, the Soviet press is now making general remarks on the material which has been transmitted by Radio Liberation.

4. No specific date was set-up for the next meeting. Subject was informed that he would be contacted by phone.
