4. informed that he had met URBAN in Austria. He described URBAN as an "old head at the game" and predicted that with the rebirth of the German Service, URBAN would affiliate with them. added that he had talked with URBAN about getting exemplars of Dowod Osobisty and had offered 3,000 schillings each. URBAN apparently agreed to attempt to procure the documents. agreed that the price was reasonable, provided any products were genuine, and that we undoubtedly would take all URBAN could get.
