Josef Adolf URBAN <div style="border: 1px solid black; width: 100px; height: 15px; margin: 5px auto;"></div> Born 8 January 1897,  was traced by A-2 as being of operational interest to them in February 1959, per reference control number 515 dated 4 February 1959. We therefore suggest that MIG query A-2. If A-2 has no further interest please advise us and we will forward traces. Since Subject is extremely well known in intelligence circles we are not forwarding detailed Munich Base traces on him at this time.  2. Although Subject is possibly still of interest to A-2 we are transmitting herewith a photograph of URBAN since we feel that A-2 would not object to the passing of this item to MIG. Our files contain no physical description or occupation, but A-2 indicated that he resided in Linz as of February 1959 when they traced.  3. FYI: Subject was UPHILL's former field agent V-13690 and in response to our request for traces in February 1959 (on behalf of A-2), UPHILL stated the following:  Subject is apparently identical with Josef Adolf URBAN born 8 or 9 January 1897 in Saaz, Czechoslovakia. Subject was active for (UPHILL) from 1947 to May 1956 when he was placed in an inactive status. This action was taken because of Subject's unauthorized connections with other Western intelligence services. He was allegedly working with the French IS, British IS and CIC. He was dropped in May 1958. Subject was under investigation by the Austrian authorities in December 1958. (NOFORN). Subject's aliases include Stephan URBAN and Stephan ERBAN.  4. Recently during an informal discussion with UPHILL's SMUENZER on well known intelligence swindlers, Subject's name came up and SMUENZER commented that UPHILL suspects that Subject is now working for the Yugoslavs. In view of para. 4 of Reference, which indicates that Subject may be a sub-source of MIG, we suggest that MIG authorize us to query UPHILL for any information subsequent to that UPHILL passed in February 1959, if A-2 has no further interest.
