<p>1. The BND advises that URBAN was terminated (in 1956) after an investigation of his methods developed derogatory information. On 15 November 1961 URBAN was mentioned in an East German broadcast and it was stated that he was an employee of the BND. In 1961 in connection with the EICHMANN trial the West German authorities had URBAN on their wanted list but the result is not known. The BND has no information as to URBAN's current whereabouts.</p> <p>2. The only additional information in Munich files is a contact reported dated 12 October 1960 indicating that the BND had reason to believe URBAN was involved with the Yugoslav Intelligence Service. We have no traces on Luigi TERZETTA.</p>
