SUBJECT: GENERAL: Possible Trip to Argentina of Somewhat  
Prominent Hungarian Fascist  
SPECIFIC: Information Concerning Ferenc WAJTA

(1) This branch has been notified that one Ferenc WAJTA (VLCSEK, VLTSCHER), a Hungarian who is still actively pro-German, anti-Communist and anti-American, might possibly soon proceed to Argentina from Rome. The following somewhat superficial information concerning subject is forwarded for your information for purposes of identifying him should he come to your attention in the future. In the event that more details on subject should be needed by you, you have but to request them.

(2) In March subject was in Madrid, ostensibly to arrange for the transportation there of one thousand Hungarian children from Austria and Germany. Actually, he is the representative of an anti-Russian movement called Internarium. The source of this information is of the opinion that Wajta is also working with the French General Staff. Subject is reputed to be a man without scruples or principles and the most dangerous demagogue in Hungary. He appears to have jumped from one sponsor to another (if the change were to his advantage), but he has consistently been, as has been stated, pro-Nazi, anti-Communist and violently anti-American and anti-British. It is in connection with Hungarian refugees that subject might come to Argentina. A letter from him which has been intercepted states that the Holy See is interested in assisting thirty thousand such refugees in emigrating to Spain and/or Argentina. In this letter subject states, "Soon I shall go to Buenos Aires with the Jesuits."

(3) Subject was a known German agent in Hungary, and was picked up by the OSS in mid-1945 in Salzburg. The latest report concerning him is that he was recently arrested in Rome by the Questura at the direct request of Eugenio Reale, Italian Communist and Under-secretary of Foreign Affairs. It is understood, however, that Premier de Gasperi is interested in obtaining his release.
