1. The subject plans to leave Colombia for Europe about 16 December 1953. He has asked for a leave of absence from his teaching posts at the University of Los Andes and the National Pedagogical Institute, but his present intentions are not to return to this country. He expects to go to Lisbon first and then to Paris and Rome. He has no definite plans concerning his activities in Europe, but he hopes to contact former friends, chiefly Hungarians, and possibly line up something in the news or propaganda fields. His interest lies in those lines, and he insists that he is anxious to do something to combat Communism.
2. There are attached two papers prepared by Vajta himself. No attempt has been made to correct the grammar or spelling. It is believed that the information therein may be of some interest to Headquarters. Of late Vajta has been contemplating the formation of a Fifth International, which would unite many anti-Communist exile groups in a common purpose and campaign.
3. Prior to the subject's departure there will be obtained from him addresses where he may be contacted in Paris and Rome.
