MEMORANDUM FOR THE FILE

SUBJECT: Ferenc VAJTA ✓

1. On 17 February 1956 the Consul advised this office that Subject was applying for a visa, at which time the file was reviewed.
2. On 18 February [] stated that Subject was very anti-Communist from all that could be determined about his actions in Bogota. He stated Subject had been teaching at the University of Los Andes here at one point and that the "leftists" in that University had seen to it that Subject was removed from his position.
3. [] stated that Subject was very intelligent, had a large number of connections in the country, and that he spoke some five languages well. He thought Subject had been a Hungarian Nazi and possibly still held pro-Nazi sentiments.
