Subject: Working Society for Politics

A branch of the Right-oriented Working Society for Politics (Arbeitsgemeinschaft fuer Politik - AFP) has been founded in Salzburg. There are now local groups of the AFP in all Austrian provinces except Tyrol and Vorarlberg. The main organization is located in Vienna at Wuerffelgasse 6/9.

The chairman of the Salzburg chapter of the AFP is:

Herbert ^{X no 201} O L B R I C H, born 22 September 1925 in Vienna, dentist, residing in 5071/Wals near Salzburg, Siesenheim 48. OLBRIKH is a well-known local Rightist and is also a member of the youth group "Falkenstein."

The first meeting of the Salzburg AFP chapter was held at 1930 on 20 February 1973 in the Hotel Pitter in Salzburg. The meeting was organized under paragraph 2 of the laws on assembly so that only invited guests were admitted.

The speaker of the evening was the former Sturmabfuhrer of the Flemish SS

Robert Jan ^{X no 201} V E R B E L E N, Austrian citizen, journalist, residing in Vienna XIX, Greinergasse 36/3/1. He addressed the 300 to 350 guests on the topic of "World Politics and the Secret Service", employing stories based on his experiences in intelligence during World War II. He also alluded several times to work for U.S. intelligence in Vienna. After the lecture, VERBELEN sold copies of his books, most of which are spy stories.
