1. Area of Operations and Headquarters: Germany, Karlsruhe (Berlin Operations Base).
2. References: None
3. Aims: a) Objectives: Total production of uranium ore in the Soviet Zone of Germany  
           b) Targets : Operating procedure and personnel of the main administration of Wismut, A.G.; as well as of the Soviet Transport and ore washing units in Saxony.  
           c) Tasks : Agent will collect from numerous sub-sources data on the day to day movement of trucks and trains to and from the main administration of Wismut, A.G. In addition he will debrief sub-agents on operating procedure and personnel in the uranium mining field.
4. Personnel: CAMBIC (LEB-A-3658), CAMBICs 2 through 10 and other casual sub-sources (LEB-A-3904 - 3905).
5. Cover: CAMBIC has been issued a false identity card as a mechanical engineer resident in Plauen which enables him to travel around in the Wismut mining area with fairly good cover.
6. Contacts and Communications: CAMBIC has a LEB agent phone number where he can reach case officer. He is contacted only by going to his home. He is met at a prearranged spot in the United States Sector of Berlin and driven to a safe-house. Agent can mail letters to sub-agents from Jüterberg. They can, if necessary write a postcard to his mother-in-law in West Berlin.

10. Timetable: GAMBIO is a developmental project which can be run on a continuing basis if the information gathered warrants it.
11. Estimated Cost: While agent is being developed, he will be paid 200 Westmarks monthly. If the project is continued, it is planned to pay him 300 Westmarks monthly. Operating expenses, mainly travel and incidental payments to sub-agents, will run at 500 Ostmarks monthly. Expenses for period July-December 1951 will be:

Salary	1750 Westmarks
Operating expenses:	3000 Ostmarks

12. Special Problems and Commitments: Retroactive approval is requested for payments made to agent in period 16 March to 30 June 1951 amounting to approximately 550 Westmarks and 1000 Ostmarks.
