\*Formal Report on Carriage Test of Subject of ~~MEM-A~~  
on 22 August 1951.

1. Object of test: Specific.
2. Procedure: Standard.
3. Anticipated Reliability of the Test Results: Subject was strongly but erratically responsive. Results are estimated to be "fairly reliable", in the scale of "reliable", "fairly reliable", and "unreliable".
4. Summary of Test Results: Subject's identity is a sore point with him, although he appears to be the person he claims to be. Subject does not appear to be a Soviet or Communist agent. Subject does not make the impression of being an habitual criminal, but appears to have a few crimes on his conscience.

Subject appears to be telling the truth regarding the fiasco involving identity B in the Cafe identity C but appears otherwise to be concealing facts concerning his relations with identity B. Subject appears to be lying to a considerable extent about his connections with identity A and the affair of the packing slips. There appear also to be some major inaccuracies or loopholes in the story concerning the loss of the geiger counter and the electroscope, as well as his allegations concerning his part in the explosion in identity D.

Subject is, however, apparently in contact with friends in the identity E area and does not appear to be conducting a notional operation. His motivation is apparently more complex than he has stated, although he himself appears to know quite well what his motives are. He appears to be involved with some special but non-Communist group.

5. Operator's Appraisal of Subject: Definitely a deviant of some sort; bizarre in dress and speech. One gets the impression of a romanticist who would like to be a dare-devil but may lack the ingredients. He might, nevertheless, be capable of very rash actions when sufficiently stimulated.
6. Remarks & Recommendations: All questions concerning identity A strongly upset the subject in a way that indicates that he is at least withholding important information concerning this person. If identity A could be induced to come to be interviewed, a great deal of light would almost certainly be shed on the whole matter.
