In message 14 of 9 December 1953, CASIRO 2 reports "My friend Georg --- works as the foreman (PERZINIS) of a garage. He occasionally travels on business to Moscow. He arranges for automobile trips and issues travel orders (colasinas). On Sundays he would be able to make a motor trip to Pskov and other closer cities" --- In message 13 of 15 March 1954, CASIRO 2 further reported: "My foremost helper is my cousin "George" --- During Vienna time was not associated with any type of organization. During the German occupation, served in the German Army in a technical section. At the end of the war he deserted. He has an exceptional ability to adapt himself to existing conditions. He helped me recover my buried equipment. He now gives me material support and assistance in my work. He is acquainted with our work and the basic principles of conspiratorial activity."

In message 13 (second part) of 16 March 1954, CASIRO 2 reported: "--I listen to your broadcasts in his apartment. As a garage manager he can get an auto for his personal needs at any time ---"

In message 4 of 30 October 1952, CASIRO reported: "All that was buried --- has been brought to me ---"

In message 5 of 10 March 1953, CAUSO 2 reports "I have personal contact with two men -- Because of conditions one helper knows pretty nearly all about me."

George is first mentioned by name in message 10 of 8 August 1953, (one year after dispatch). The last two references however, apparently apply to "George" inasmuch as later reports from CAUSO 2 indicate it was he who recovered CAUSO 2's equipment and is also the one person among all of CAUSO 2's contacts who is the most knowledgeable of the entire operation. If the assumption is accepted that message number 2 constitutes a reference to George, it would indicate then, that CAUSO 2 has been in contact with George since at least 18 October 1952.

**b. Operational activity**

Recovered CAUSO 2 buried equipment at some time prior to 18 October 1952.

Reported positive intelligence on 8 August 1953.

Assisted CAUSO 2 in servicing the British cache on 15 November 1953.

Established a cache in Lithuania on 6 December 1953.

Made available to CAUSO 2 his apartment as a safe house since at least 19 February 1954.

Carried out and reported on an exploratory operational trip from Riga to Petrosavodsk and return on 3-7 April 1954.

In Message 18 (second part) of 16 March 1954, CA:USC 2 reports: "--- I have known him since childhood. He is by nature a very quiet person --- because of the nature of his character and his nationalistic feelings would be very suited for our work --- he is very suspicious by nature ---"

According to information furnished by CA:USC 2 on possible contacts prior to his dispatch on 1 September 1952: "from PRESNIKANS worked, during German time, on VEF (State Electrical Appliance Factory) in the Radio department as an electrical engineer. When last seen in 1944 lived near Skiratave railroad station. Now (1952) about 40 years old. A distant relative from mother's side. Single. Engaged in some black market activities during German times."

Although it is not possible to pin-point the address given, it is interesting to note that Krastpils iela is located one block away from the Skiratave railroad station. The first mention of LAPRA occurs in message 7 of 13 May 1953 when CA:USC 2 gives his name and address and states that he has already told us about him.

**b. Operational activity**

Serves as a letter drop for the receipt of internal USSR mail.

Two letters were mailed to him internally and CA:USC 2 confirmed the receipt of one on 12 September 1953.
