MAEFLE, Karl Heinz

1. SUBJECT, a known swindler, is wanted by the German police for representing himself as an LfV agent.

2. Information pertaining to description and background of SUBJECT is as follows:

Name: as above

Date & Place of Birth: 5 January 1929 at DITTELHEIM

Political & Case History: SUBJECT was in jail from 1950 to 1952 for misrepresentation and swindling. Upon his release he approached the LfV with fairly good information regarding KPD personalities and organizations. Following this SUBJECT went by taxi to the Innenministerium in BONN and, posing as an LfV agent, offered a proposition whereby he would submit plans of KPD underground movements. SUBJECT received little satisfaction in BONN and proceeded to MUNICH and other places by taxi, always failing to pay the fare. SUBJECT was apprehended, but due to insufficient proof regarding the misrepresentation he received only a one-month sentence. Upon release MAEFLE continued his venture, accumulating taxi bills and charging them to the LfV of the Innenministerium of the various states in which he had contacts. All West German police agencies have been alerted to be on the lookout for SUBJECT.

3. It is desired that SUBJECT be entered in the Master Personality Index of your area as undesirable for future use in any field of intelligence.

He worked as a gardener until 1949, first in LwOW, then in OSOWO/STETTIN where the Germans moved his family in 1945. In 1949 SUBJECT secured employment with the British Forces as a driver in HAMBURG. However, in the same year he moved to the American Zone and joined Labor Service on 19 June at FARGE. SUBJECT has no political or military history.

Political & Case History: SUBJECT was born in HATRODE, but moved with his parents to ROSSLAU in 1912. He attended grade and high school from 1919 to 1930. From 1931 to 1945 he served in the German Army. In 1945 he was a US POW. He was discharged in 1945, and after working three (3) months with the city administration in HANNOVER, he joined his mother in DESSAU. In 1946 he joined the LDP, DESSAU, and was elected 2nd Chairman. In March 1947 he was elected to the Vorstand Bezirksverband, DESSAU, and served until it was dissolved in late 1948. In 1949 SUBJECT moved to BERLIN and became Chief of the Main Department for Internal Administration. In September 1951 he was given a pay raise and a promotion to Assistant Chief of the Main Department for Organization. He was also the 1st Chairman of the LDP Bezirksverband Prenzlauerberg in BERLIN (East).
