Journalist; agent for different intelligence agencies. Listed as Category 5 (3) contact of USAGE, through BITSCHNAU; in contact with the USIS and the BIS. (Chart 9).

2. MGLA-2272, 14 June 50

Info from GV "A" in re the "AJAC" terrorist group: Dr. Leopold VOLLER of Salzburg was suspected in connection with a documentation fraud and was arrested in Feldkirch. (One Walfgang Emanuel von ROTENBURG of Feldkirch was arrested for a phony uranium deal and attempted swindle of a Geneva merchant named KAISER; he also worked in intelligence for the US, served as courier for a legitimist group, and procured documentation for Walter MUSSERLEITNER, who is involved with "AJAC.") In custody ROTENBURG stated that subject in recent years had interrogated POWs for the benefit of the US.

Ref: MGLA-1795, 18 Apr 50, from USAGE: BITSCHNAU had an intelligence connection to subject, who then worked for a French Capt. ~~GALLIEN in Feldkirch.~~

USAGE info of 5 Jan 50: Under cover number C-50 ^{Pitschnau?} subject worked until the beginning of 1948 as a sub-source of C-1. About 1 Jan 48 he switched to GREENE, CID Salzburg. He was arrested, with dope, on a narcotics charge but his release was effected, after he stated he worked for US intelligence, by DE NOVI, CID Salzburg. Subject has informed C-1 that he is in direct contact with OFFSPRING and has received binding promises for the placing of his presumed collaborators. He claims to have a strong intelligence organization of his own, specializing in collecting communist information, influencing US authorities by doing so, direct counter intelligence, offensive work against the CP, splitting the CP, and influencing the press. He asked C-1 to contact the Tyrolisan Catholic periodical Volksbote, to make arrangements for publishing subject's submissions without revealing his authorship. Subject also informed C-1 that he had reached agreement with his "US connection" whereby he could sever same on any first of the month for the end of that month.

USAGE report P/01389, 1 May 50, re "Zentralstelle zur Bekämpfung des Marxismus", proposed by subject should be compared. Subject is described as an intelligence man, in intelligence contact with BITSCHNAU for many years, and also as having had contacts to various Western intelligence organizations.
