With regard to paragraph 3 of Reference, the sub-source of the report on Subject transmitted with EAVI- 2674 is Leopold VOLLER [ ] We do not know the identity of VM-23, the GRENBOAP source of EAV- 7404, and tend to doubt that GRENBOAP would describe VOLLER as an "untried source", since GRENBOAP is undoubtedly aware of the fact that VOLLER is probably as "tried" a source as exists in Austria. It is possible, of course, that VM-23 obtained the information contained in EAV- 7404 from VOLLER. When [ ] returns from home leave, we will ask him to clarify this matter by requesting from GRENBOAP more detailed data on the ultimate source of the information contained in EAV- 7404.</p> <p>2. Note to Salzburg Base: Previous communications from Vienna have advised that VOLLER is a "paper mill" and probably also an outright fabricator when he feels he should produce more than his sources provide. He also comes up from time to time with good information, and he appears to have a wide range of sources. We suggest that [ ] discuss this matter once again with [ ] advising the latter that VOLLER's voluminous reporting is always downgraded by us to the point where it is practically worthless. [ ] should press for detailed source data that will clearly identify the ultimate source of each item of information as well as the circumstances under which the information was obtained from this ultimate source. The Anna Maria BLAZEJOVA report mentioned above should be used as a case in point, and we suggest that VOLLER be asked to submit a new report on BLAZEJOVA containing every bit of information that VOLLER knows about BLAZEJOVA and her activities, <u>plus</u> a detailed accounting of how each item of information was obtained.</p> <p>3. Until such time as we have clarified the ultimate sources of the information contained in both of the above-mentioned reports, we cannot provide a firm opinion of the accuracy of these reports. We do, however, concur in what Headquarters had to say about Subject in paragraphs 1 and 2 of Reference.</p>
