SPECIFIC: Gunther PAMELKE, German Ambassador to Egypt, and
Dr. Wilhelm VOSS

According to a report, information dated January 1953, and evaluated F-3, from a well-placed source in Egypt, German advisors to the Egyptian Government regard Gunther PAMELKE, the German Ambassador, as an inefficient, stable puppet of Dr. Wilhelm VOSS. VOSS, they maintain, handles all the important work of the Embassy, assisted by his secretary, Josef TIEFENBACHER.

Source Comments: Informant alleges that VOSS is regarded both in Alexandria and Bonn as the real representative of West German interests in Egypt. Source notes that VOSS' trip to Bonn, in January, was for the purpose of discussing PAMELKE and to attempt to obtain diplomatic status for TIEFENBACHER and himself.
