SUBJECT: Lt. Col von WARNSDORF (aka WARNSTORFF)

A search of the files and indices of the Directorate of Operations contain the following information on Subject:

DOB: Circa 1912-15
CIT: German

In charge of Army Group "E" I.C (equiv our G-2) in Salonika, Greece. Functions included collating intell about the military situations in Greece, propaganda welfare of troops, direction of Greek volunteer brigades. Responsible for discipline of all Abwehr personnel; liaised with Abwehr who passed reports to him (Dec 43-Apr 44).

Reported in Vienna May 1944, attached to Abwehr Trupp 390.

Returned to Salonika July 1944.

Reported to be in Athens Oct 1944.

Reported to be in Yugolsavia Jan 1945.

Subject has been described as circa 1.78m tall, slim, light hair and eyes. Very elegant.
