Uden also revealed that, starting with his visit to Moscow in May 1954, the Swedish Government had increasingly been pressing the Russian Government for the release of Knut WALLINBERG and that recently (an unspecified date) the Russians had promised that, if Wallenberg could be found, he would be returned to Sweden.
