Subject: Case of Swedish National Raoul Wallenberg

1. Information available to this Agency on Abraham Kalinski for the period 1959-1976 indicates that on his release from prison in the Soviet Union he resided in Vladimir where he worked in a tractor factory. Mr. Kalinski contacted the United States Embassy in Moscow in 1965 where he repeated his story on his arrest and subsequent imprisonment by the Soviets. We have no additional information on Mr. Kalinski's activities in the USSR subsequent to 1965. We have no record of Mr. Kalinski in the past having been aware of the whereabouts of Mr. Wallenberg.

2. We have no information confirming Mr. Kalinski's statement regarding Mr. Dutko, a former United States Foreign Service officer serving in Moscow.
