Dear Director Deutch:

I am writing to request the declassification of Central Intelligence Agency documents which relate to the disappearance of Raoul Wallenberg. This request is made on behalf of Dr. Guy von Dardel, Raoul Wallenberg's brother, and others working in conjunction with him. The declassification of these documents would greatly assist the many organizations and private individuals investigating Raoul Wallenberg's whereabouts after World War II.

As you know, Wallenberg was a Swedish official responsible for saving tens of thousands of Jews in Nazi occupied Hungary during World War II. After the war's end, Wallenberg was apparently arrested by the Russians and on January 31, 1945, charged as an American spy. Since his disappearance, there have been many reports of Wallenberg's survival in Russian prisons.

It has now been over fifty years since Raoul Wallenberg's disappearance. It is long past time to release all documents which may shed some light on Wallenberg's whereabouts. Specifically, I request that two pages relating to Raoul Wallenberg be declassified (i.e. without redactions). Copies of these documents with redactions are enclosed. If this is not possible, I ask that I be able to view the original versions in person. Thank you.

1. ACTION REQUIRED: PLEASE PROVIDE ANY PASSABLE INFO ON WALLEBERG PRIOR COB 8 NOVEMBER.

2. [REDACTED]
ON 15 OCTOBER FOR ANY DATA ON CURRENT STATUS OF WALLEBERG, WHO DISAPPEARED AT THE END OF WW II IN HUNGARY, AND WHO, ACCORDING TO AUTHORITIES IN FORMER USSR AND CURRENT RUSSIA, IS DEAD. WHILE [REDACTED] HAD MENTIONED ISSUE IN PAST, APPARENTLY FISHING, HE NEVER ACTUALLY ASKED FOR ANY INFORMATION. ON 15 OCTOBER, [REDACTED] CAME BACK TO THE RAOUL WALLEBERG CASE. HE SAID THAT THE HEAD OF THE WALLEBERG INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE

[REDACTED] BEEN PRESSURING HIM TO DETERMINE WALLEBERG'S CURRENT STATUS, I.E., DEAD OR ALIVE AND WHERE. ISSUE HAS APPARENTLY BECOME ENOUGH OF A PROBLEM FOR HIM THAT HE HAS COME TO US FOR HELP.

3. [REDACTED] SAID THAT HE HAD ACQUIRED, OR BEEN GIVEN, AN OLD PHOTO WHICH HE HAD HAD ENLARGED OF, ALLEGEDLY, A SCENE IN A SOVIET CONCENTRATION CAMP PURPORTING TO SHOW WALLEBERG. HE HAD FOUND THE PHOTO INCONCLUSIVE. HE HAD ALSO ASKED HIS KGB LIAISON LAST YEAR FOR ANY INFORMATION, A FRUITLESS EXERCISE.

4. WE WOULD APPRECIATE ANY AUTHORITATIVE INFORMATION WHICH WE MAY PASS TO HIM. A TEAR LINE WOULD BE PREFERABLE. HOWEVER, WILL BE GLAD TO PASS IT ORALLY IF NEEDED. THANKS.
