(C) Information on file dated 23 November 1945 indicates that Kurt WALTER, born 14 July 1901 in GOERLITZ, served in the German Navy from 1920 until 1932 as a signal specialist. In 1933, HE transferred to the Gestapo, MUNICH, and in 1934 was transferred to the Sicherheitspolizei. SUBJECT was in charge of all communications and signal matters in the Reichsleitung and received the rank of Amrat. HIS nominal rank in the SS was Sturmabfuhrer. (P-6) No further pertinent information available
