1. (C) Information dated 1946 indicates that one Gerhard Wiebe, born 3 June 1912 in JORDANKEN/Dansig, was arrested on 8 June 1946 and charged with being Waffen SS Untersturmfuehrer and Allgemeine SS Untersturmfuehrer. Wiebe had been educated at Private-U Landwirtschaft-Schule, from 1918 until 1927. From 1928 until 1930 attended Hoer Landw-Schule. From 1930 until 1932 he had been employed as a farmer at F. Elbing, KUNZENDORF. From 1932 until 1935 and 1936 until 1941 served as a Pol-official and from 1941 until 1943 farmer Landw. Osteinsatz. From 1935 until 1936 served with HEER as unteroffizier and from 1942 until 1945 served in the Waffen SS as Untersturmfuehrer. Politics prior to 1933 included the NSDAP. He voted the first time for the NSDAP in 1932. He had been a member of the NSDAP from 1931 until 1932 and again from 1941 until 1945. He had been a member of the Allgemeine SS as Untersturmfuehrer from 1938 until 1945 and the Waffen SS from 1942 until 1945 serving as Untersturmfuehrer. Had been a member of the SA as SA/MANN from 1931 until 1932 and held membership in the DAF from 1941 to an unknown date and the NSV from 1938 until 1945. (Uneval)

2. (C) Information dated 28 August 1953 indicates that one Gerhard Wiebe, born 3 June 1912 in DANZIG, was rejected for immigration to Canada, reason not indicated. (Uneval) No further pertinent information available.
