It is requested that not only documents reflecting Subject's membership in Nazi organizations be forwarded but that copies of all available documents reflecting their educational, professional or other personal history up to May 1945 be included. The same individual was reportedly scheduled in 1951 to return to Iran as a W/T operator for CATIDE. According to other carded information Gustav TAETZEL (Reinrich ULRICH (201-019915) was a CATIDE agent dropped on 15 September 1951. No additional information.
