OCCUPATION: BND operations officer; assigned to the BND field office in Saarbruechen since 1960; formerly employed by the LfV/Hesse, in charge of the Kassel field office.

MARITAL STATUS: He has been married for more than twenty years. His wife lives with Subject in Kassel.

LANGUAGES: German - native.

- ASSOCIATES:
1. Karl-Heinz ENGELKE [redacted] Department chief LfV/Hesse. Subject's former supervisor.
  2. Guenter FRUEHAUF [redacted] LfV/Hesse operations officer. Subject's former colleague and (probably) his friend.
  3. Curt Walter KEIL [redacted] Former LfV/Hesse operations officer and member of the GESTAPO. KEIL, as well as Subject, were investigated by the FRG war crimes commission in Ludwigsburg for their involvement in mass killings while serving in German occupied areas of Poland and Russia during World War II. Subject's colleague and (possibly) his friend.
  4. Ernst ROSEMAN [redacted] BND operations officer. While in the employ of the BfV, ROSEMAN and Subject, (then) with the LfV/Hesse, worked against MFS targets, including the case "Fallschirm." He is believed to have been instrumental in arranging Subject's current employment with the BND.

REHOMINY/4 COMMENTS: Subject, a former member of the GESTAPO, while in the employ of the LfV/Hesse worked with ROSEMAN. (see associates above) then with the BfV, against the MFS, including the case assigned the cryptonym operation "Fallschirm." ROSEMAN is also believed to have been instrumental in arranging for Subject's employment with BND. In 1960, shortly after he had joined the BND, Subject was investigated by the FRG war crimes commission in Ludwigsburg for his activities during World War II when he was stationed in the German occupied areas in Poland and the USSR. The scope of this investigation is not known, but is believed to have covered Subject's involvement in mass killings of Russians and Jews. Subject was suspended from the BND during the investigation which had lasted more than three months.
