SUBJECT: WIRSICH, Kune, AIC 957

TO : AC of S, G-2, Third United States Army, APO 403

1. Details of Arrest. WIRSICH was sent to Third US Army Intelligence Center on 20 May 1945 from the prisoner of war enclosure in REGENSBURG.

2. Summary of Interrogation. WIRSICH is 35 years old and is a lawyer by profession. Before HITLER's rise to power he had been connected with German leftist circles, and upon request of the Communist Underground he joined the SS in BERLIN after 1933. He lost contact with the Underground after 1937 but remained in the SS. He joined the office of the Reichskommissar fuer die Festigung Deutschen Volkstums and headed its legal department from the fall of 1944 until March 1945. WIRSICH has provided valuable information on this office and its personalities as well as many secret documents which he had collected and hidden in the basement of his home.

3. Disposition. Although WIRSICH is ostensibly in an automatic arrest category, a careful study of his case indicates that he is in no way a security threat at this time. Accordingly, he is being released at the request of USFET.
