1. CAMISADE FULLY SELF-SUPPORTING. PRESENTS OF FOOD AND CIGARETTES NEEDED BY ALL GERMANS. HIS ACCEPTANCE NO INDICATION VAGRANCY.
2. CAMISADE HAD NOT BEEN CONTACTED BY SOVIETS SINCE EARLY AUG. 48 UNTIL 3 FEB. 49. HIS SOVIET CASE OFFICER, ROSTOVIEV, THEN ASKED HIM MAKE EVERY EFFORT REOPEN CONTACT WITH NOTIONAL WEBB (BSC/OPS/173, KAPOK B 76).
3. WHEN, IN SUMMER 48, WE BEGAN CONSIDERING CAMISADE FOR RADIO WE TOLD HIM INFORM SOVIETS ALL CONTACT WITH WEBB BROKEN OFF. WE HENCE TOLD CAMISADE TELL ROSTOVIEV AT PRESENT IMPOSSIBLE REOPEN CONTACT WITH WEBB. WE ARE INCLINED THIS MOVE PERSONAL VAGARY OF ROSTOVIEV NOT TO BE TAKEN SERIOUSLY BY US PENDING SOME EVIDENCE WHAT HE WANTS.
