WENGER Hauptsturmfuehrer

German; 42-45; big, strong build; height 5'11"-6'; fair hair, sparse, cut very short; blue eyes; round face; pale complexion; appearance of a Prussian officer, usually seen in uniform; knows how to command but very pleasant speaking voice. Peculiarities: often puts hands on hips when he talks. Languages: German and French.

Seen: S.D., 81 Avenue Foch, Paris. German Embassy, 2 Rue Huysmanns, Paris. For the last time: Nancy, towards the 25/26 August 1944.

Note: He was sent to Lunville Baccarat with 30 men to fight the Maquis. Two days after his arrival in the town, his group arrested a W/T operator with radio. The operator had only just been parachuted into this corner of Meurthe and Moselle. WENGER arranged measures taken against parachutists, or arrests (sic). He is a diplomat, ably assisted by SCHUMANN and FOSSELT, who also belong to the diplomatic corps. They had with them stamps and other materials necessary for the issue of passports, which was done at Nancy. During the retreat they made anyone a German if they wished it.

"In June 1940, informant met OLTRAMARE in the German Embassy in Paris and was told that the latter was working for Hauptsturmfuehrer WENGER and Dr. SCHUMANN, who were the liaison men between SD and the German Embassy. WENGER was the man who issued travel permits to Germans who wanted to come to Paris. He had his office in the Hotel "Palais d'Orsay" in rooms 135, 151, 152."
