SUBJECT: Dr. Karl von WINKLER, Rusty Agent

19 November 1948

1. On 15 November 1948 one of our sources received a letter from Lt. Col. TRABER, Swiss I.S. Eastern Division, Bern, which stated the following:

"On 14 October 1948, Dr. von WINKLER was here again. However, he could not see me because I was sick at home. He then dictated a few points to my deputy. WINKLER among other things, requested the following:

- a) About 300 to 400 machine pistols
- b) 60 pistols
- c) 100 automatic rifles with telescopic sights
- d) 10 to 12 W/T apparatus
- e) 200 kilos explosives with fuses, as well as plastic explosives
- f) First aid material for 700 to 800 men including individual first aid kits, field hospital equipment, etc.
- g) Food supplies for 700 to 800 men including emergency rations and winter camouflage jackets.

"We can use any type of sabotage material which can be delivered to us. We also intend to start from the Air Force point of view what we have already started in connection with ground force preparations. Can our Air Force expert come here in order to meet your appropriate man? He was a Major in the German Air Force, a fighter pilot, Ritterkreustrager, and was never a Nazi Party member.

"Could we bring along a few W/T operators for training?"
