<p>Excerpt of letter from Barbara Spofford Morgan to DeWitt</p> <p>Dear DeWitt, I sent your memorandum to Rose, telling her that it is confidential. You can rely on her discretion.</p> <p>She says that Bruening told her some months ago that Kaas was no longer on good terms with the Pope. As you know that Bruening and Kaas are in opposition you will make some allowance for wish thinking in this statement; still I do not discard it, first because Bruening is not a liar and secondly because he has excellent sources of information, as I have seen in the past. Leiber is said not to mix much in politics. Rose confirms that Wirth and Bruening are not on good terms. Contrary to the Matthews story, Rose says that Kaas opposes dismemberment of the Reich, as Wirth does also, and it is the major point on which they both agree with Bruening.
