<p>4. It appeared to source that the German delegates were the only conferees to show a real interest in the goal of the conference. Among the, Johannes Dieckmann, President of the People's Chamber, played a prominent role. He opposed the stand taken by the French delegates, but, apart from that, worked for conciliation in all discussions. The final resolution taken at the conference was due, chiefly, to his efforts to reach an acceptable compromise.
