SUBJECT: **Travel Document for use in the Balkan Countries**

NOTE: As a business man WISCHMANN is interested in knowing how and where to procure documents for travel outside Germany. As a German it is almost impossible for him to receive the necessary permits in any legal manner, for there is no legal way for a German to get American permission to make exploratory business trips outside the American Zone.

1. WISCHMANN knows a certain stateless Russian (he did not want to pry into the man's business and so to scare him - and, therefore, does not know his name) who lives in St. Gilgen, Austria from whom he can at any time purchase (for 150-200 dollars) the necessary documents for travel into any Balkan country, even as German.

2. WISCHMANN was instructed to find the Russian's name, address, and something of the man's past history. WISCHMANN will do this in due time; to speed up the operation we might call for assistance from SS/Salsburg. Since St. Gilgen is only a few kilometers outside of this Salsburg, and since it is a very small village which may not have many Russian inhabitants, it may be a simple matter for SSU/Salsburg to trace the man. - In passing this tip to Salsburg, it is advisable to ask them to take extra caution so as not to scare the man. For even without assistance from Salsburg we will find everything we need to know through WISCHMANN.
