

EXTRACT FROM THE GERMAN PRIMER

SUBJECT: Karl WOLFF (Former SS General)

DOB: 13 May 1900

Subject was a lieutenant in the Heissische Freikorps from 1918 to 1920. From March to June 1933, he was adjutant to General Von Epp. In 1942 he was head of the Personnel staff of the RFSS. During the period 1941-42, he often visited Hitler's Headquarters. Subject visited Finland with Himmler in August 1942, and was with the RSHA in Dec. 1942. Subject is believed to have owned a Villa on Lake Como, and owns a castle near Berlin.
