- d) the subject alien was arrested by the U.S. Forces in 1945 and interned for 4 years in various camps. During this time the subject was charged with various crimes including the torture of civilians.

These points in particular characterize a lengthy career in the cause of National Socialism.

In view of this record it is believed that the applicant may be ineligible for a visa under section 212(a)(9) of the Immigration and Nationality Act. However, if further information does not produce any record of conviction of a crime involving moral turpitude, ineligibility would, in accordance with 22 CFR 42.42(a)(9), require the admission by the applicant of the commission of the essential elements constituting such a crime. The applicant has not made such admission.

Consideration should also be given to the possible reaction in the United States of General Wolff's admission. A determination that his admission would cause disturbances which may endanger the welfare or safety of the country could disqualify him under section 212(a)(27). The Consulate General will appreciate receiving the Department's advice, based on its previous experience with similar cases, concerning this determination.

If the subject applicant is determined ineligible to receive a visa, the Consulate General is not prepared to recommend temporary admission under 212(d)(5) of the Act.

The Department's prompt consideration of this case will be appreciated.
