1957, 22 Jan: Herbert WEINMANN implicated some member of the UPSWING School Staff 1953 as MFS (East German State Security) agent. Eventually, UPSWING concluded that the staff member was (Dr) (med) Hans KORTZ. The case is still current. KORTZ is under investigation, apparently realizes this, and consults every decision he has to make with his father-in-law, Rudolf Johannes KORSECK, Chief of the School, and WOLFF, UPSWING's Security Section considers WOLFF as something of a gray eminence on the case and is probably holding the key to its solution. WOLFF is still an UPSWING staff member as of this date (22 Jan 57). KORTZ has now received an assignment in Mains, the purpose of which is to separate him from his previous work. It is an individual assignment which concerns the use of medical knowledge in the intelligence business.

April 22, 1944 - detailed to the "Nebeltruppenerschule Celle,

June 26, 1944 - detailed to the Panzer Truppen Schule Bergen, Lager Fallingb., Panzer Junker courses, with the last three units he

was in charge of ideological training. As of January 1, 1945, Wolff became a "Fachführer" with the rank of an Obersturmbannführer/Lt. Col. (Jan. 1, 1945), unit: "Ergänzung". Wolff was holder of the golden HJ badge and of the "Ehrenzeichen des NSD-Studentenbundes".

Wolff studied theology in Warsaw and Erlangen from October 28 until July 33.

From September 19, 1933, to September 19, 1934, he served in the Polish Army, last rank: Vizefeldwebel und Reserveoffiziers-Anwärter/sergeant and reserve-officer's-cadet.

He passed the reserve-officer's examination but was not promoted to lieutenant because of political reasons.

In May 1926, Wolff built up a youth group which was the nucleus of the German "Erneuerungsbewegung" in Poland.

From 1929 to 1931 he was "Landesführer" of the German "Jungenschaft" in Poland.

Member of the "Verein deutscher Hochschüler in Warsaw; deputy chairman of the "Verband deutscher Hochschüler" in Warsaw during the following year.

By order of the "Reichsjugendführung" and of the "Volksbund für das Deutsche Ausland" he took over the management of the youth-work (Jugendarbeit) in Poland on a salaried full time basis (Oct. 1, 1934-).

From 1935 until 1939 he held a leading position in the "Deutscher Volksverband" in Poland.

According to his own statement he was taken into custody in 1939 for the 3rd time and was imprisoned in various Polish prisons until he fled to the German troops in September 1939.

Effective September 20, 1939, he was taken over into the HJ as an "Oberbannführer" (Colonel).

From Jan. 30, 1940, to Feb., 1942, he was "Kreisleiter" of the district of Litzmannstadt of the NSDAP.

Member of the "Reichstag" (July 8, 1940-).

Place of birth: Pabianice or Pabianitz, Probably Pabianice, district of Lask, Poland.

Occupation: Theologian, Kreisleiter of the NSDAP, SS-Führer (general SS) exact dates are not known.
