## MEMO FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: CATIDE Double Agent Case

REFS : A. EGMA-65607, 24 November 1964  
B. MUNI-2397, 2 April 1965

1. Reference A suggested Ernst WORM [ ] and Dr. Emmerich OFCZAREK [ ] as two eligible candidates for the CATIDE case officer in an unidentified CATIDE double-agent case run against the Czechs, which was reported by KUBARK [ ]

2. Subsequently, the case was identified as CATIDE's "MONOGRAMM" operation. Reference 2 reported the agent to be Hans Erich SCHOEBEL [ ] GGRAMM and the CATIDE case officer in 1960 was Gerhard BARTKE [ ] KUBARK encrypted this case "PEPPERMILL."

3. The KUBARK file on this case is found in SCHOEBEL's dossier, and neither apparently WORM nor OFCZAREK was involved.
