MEMO FOR THE RECORD:

SUBJECT: UJ DREADFUL

1. I have read the UJ DREADFUL file, including [] Carriage report. I think it highly likely that UJ DREADFUL is indeed a Soviet or Czech agent, or has been one in the past. The suspicious circumstances surrounding his detention by the Red Army, the letter denouncing him, and [] firm conclusions all throw great suspicion on him.

2. I must note, however, that one other explanation of his Carriage reactions is barely possible, namely: that his guilt feelings are engendered by some assignment, ^{has} given him against the AIS. Even though [] questions are aimed at RIS or STB connections, any type of anti-UJ tie could engender such reactions.

3. The two senior Carriage men who reviewed the case are, I believe, [] and []. ~~Perhaps~~ Perhaps they can give us some substantiation of []'s findings. I do agree with 25/50C that [] often goes very far afield in his psychological evaluations of people.
