Memorandum for the Record

Subject: V-3597 and 50/S/I

Just prior to the beginning of an operational meeting at CSW on 5 June 1953, V-3597 passed a letter to Winter. Although I did not observe the address, I am quite sure that Winter is using V-3597's Munich address as a letter drop. The letter was from one of Winter's wartime secretaries who is now married to one Wild, fnu, who had something to do with the production of the German musical comedy "Feuerwerk", and contained a family picture with new child. This aroused some of the usual comment. Winter and V-3597 also made reference to telephone calls at the latter's house and Winter commented how well Weber's wife had handled the situation. Obviously Winter is also using Weber as a telephone drop. Since Winter's wife was also referred to (Weber's wife answered a call for Winter, said he was not there, and that his wife had just left to do some shopping) it is implied that they both live there. Weber's address at present is Elisabethstrasse 33, Munich, telephone number 362158.
