SUBJECT: UJ-DREADFUL

1. the 159 ELBE file contains material on AIS, Zipper and GIS shenanigans , IS & CE-wise re Czech Elbe River steamship line's personnel. One of these documents, an Org. report mentions a "Gelegenheits V-Mann E.W." of GV G, who was attempting to recruit KUCERA and who also asked for OB info. 25.50/C thought this could conceivably refer to Subject, who is known to have some kind of a contact in the Hamburg area. I have asked 40 to check this out. *See atchd. M/R.*

2. Subsequently I asked 40/P-1 (RISCHKE) for general information on the CSPL (Czech Elbe SS line), particularly with reference to any prospective contacts therein in order to avoid crossing lines with any of our people already in there. He stated that he would have to check the file, for the reference, but that Dr. KOMMERT (of GSW) had borrowed it 4-6 weeks ago, saying that he understood that it contained info on the CSPL in the Hamburg area, a matter of great interest to GSW (or 50). He never returned the file and now claims not to remember anything about it. RISCHKE is at a loss to understand such an unusual happening. (I have not discussed the Subject case with RISCHKE, merely asking him to report this remarkable incident to 40, who is aware of Subject case).
