M/R: UJDREADFUL.

[ ] conferred. He very suspicious of the BND and its possible infiltration; specifically dubious about WORDRAK. I reminded him of the UJDREADFUL case and pointed out that this case actually leads into the bowels not only of the BND but of our own service, since it is remarkable how this man was sacrosanct. I inferred that possibly he was "nash" all the time on another wave-length, but E. K said there was no evidence of this. I pointed out against the need to investigate the circumstances surrounding the 1957 pulling of DREADFUL's files for the first time in the Berlin Docs Center, with disclosure of RSHA ~~in~~ membership and the alleged lack of knowledge of [ ] that these files either existed or ~~had~~ had been pulled.

Seems to me that if someone in 1953 was seriously interested in getting the goods on UJDREADFUL that by 1957 they would have long since pulled the Berlin Doc Center file on him.

[ ] called *file 05/16/66* in my presence and asked to have the Dreadful file sent up to him again.

7 July 1966

[ ] expressed an interest in the case. Sent him Xerox my hold file.
