TECHNICAL INTERROGATION REPORT

Operational/FOB/AEMARSH

Subject: AEMARSH-1

1. Subject was afforded a technical interview on 16 July 1958 in Frankfurt at the request of [redacted]. The interview was conducted in the English language.

2. Type of Case:

Subject is a 46 year old principal agent who has been associated with this Agency for approximately 6 years. Subject was born in Latvia and during 1943-44, he served with the Latvian Legion as a 2nd Lieutenant. Subject attended the University of Riga but did not graduate. Subject was a POW of the British in Denmark.

3. Purpose of Interview:

Since Subject has not previously been given a technical interview, it was requested by his case officer to afford Subject such an interview in order to bring his file up to date. In the absence of any specific points to be covered, Subject was given a routine interview with emphasis being placed on Subject's connections with any other intelligence service besides American and whether Subject has disclosed his connection with AIS to any unauthorized persons.

4. Report of Interview:

(a) The following relevant questions were asked on Test #1:

1. Have you ever been a member of any Communist organization?

Answer: No.

2. Have you deliberately given us any false biographical information?

Answer: No.

3. Besides American, have you ever worked for any other intelligence service?

Answer: No.

4. Besides American, do you now have any connections with any other intelligence service?

Answer: No.

5. Other than you mentioned, did you ever belong to any political organizations about which you did not tell us?

Answer: No.

Regarding this question, Subject stated, during the pre-technical interview, that in 1934 he belonged to the PERKONKRUSTS (Swastika League). This organization was declared illegal in Latvia.

6. Have you ever told any unauthorized persons about your connections with AIS?

Answer: No.

7. Do you have any secret intelligence connections not known to us?

Answer: No.

Subject's charts reflected no significant responses indicative of deception regarding the relevant questions asked in Test #1.

(b) The following relevant questions were asked on Test #2:

8. Is there anything in your life which could be used against you for blackmail purposes?

Answer: No.

9. Have you ever been convicted for committing a crime?

Answer: No.

10. Have you ever been treated by a psychiatrist?

Answer: No.

11. Have you ever used narcotics without a doctor's prescription?

Answer: No.

12. Have you ever engaged in homosexual relations?

Answer: No.

Subject's charts reflected no significant responses indicative of deception regarding the relevant questions asked in Test #2.
