1. In checking through old FOB/SOV files which are marked for destruction, it was noted that some follow-up action with AEMARSH/1 (see references) in regard to the [ ] and AEMARSH cases may not be reflected in Headquarters' records.

2. For Headquarters' information, FOB/SOV recontacted AEMARSH/1 and requested him to contact personally the current drops which he recruited and to ask them to send any agent mail from the USSR directly to a new accommodation address in Frankfurt. AEMARSH/1 agreed, and on 13-17 March 1961, he traveled to Hamburg and Mannheim and personally contacted the appropriate live letter drops, giving them the instructions regarding a new forwarding address and informing them to expect letters (test letters) from within Germany monthly as well as occasional letters from the USSR. The following data now applies to these letter drops, which were turned over to FOB/SO in May 1961:

a. AEVAIN( ) (drop for AEMARSH( )):

2) New Forwarding Procedures: Agent mail placed unopened in an envelope with the alias "K. Frank, z.Z. Hamburg" as sender and mailed to the accommodation address "Paul Wittkak, Postfach 2151, Frankfurt/Main."

b. AEVAIN/14 (drop for [ ] )

1) Name: See Identity/2 of attachment under separate cover.

2) New Forwarding Procedures: Agent mail placed unopened in an envelope with the alias "B. Altmann, z. Z. Mannheim" as sender and mailed to the accommodation address "Paul Wittkak, Postfach 2151, Frankfurt/Main."

2) New Forwarding Procedures: Agent mail placed unopened in an envelope with the alias "D. Indus" as sender and mailed to the accommodation address "Paul Wittkak, Postfach 2151, Frankfurt/Main."

3. AEMARSH/1, who got out of the TB sanatorium in July, contacted POB/SOV on 24 August 1961 to ask if there was a part-time job in intelligence work available for him. He was told that the work in which he had been engaged before termination was still inactive, but that we appreciated his personal co-operation in contacting the letter drops (AEVAINS) for us and that we would contact him if something should develop in the future. At that time AEMARSH/1 said he could be contacted c/o Latvian National Council, Germany, since he had not yet decided where to live. He said that he was still in touch with his friends who were serving as letter drops (AEVAINS( ), ( ), ( )) and that all the data furnished in March was still current.
