c. The Hungarian Union, (established by Count B. TELEKI's group), headquarters are in Innsbruck where there are two other Hungarian emigre organizations, namely, the Military organization under General ZAKO and the Catholic Church set up under Mons. Joasaf ZAGON. There is a good understanding between the "Union" and General ZAKO. General ZAKO recently made an extensive trip in Western Europe in connection with military matters, visiting France, the United Kingdom and Spain. (The Spanish visit appears significant in view of the greatly increased refugee interest in Spain and Spanish support of the emigres). ZAGON was appointed by the Pope to head up the Hungarian Catholic church in exile. He has the authority and functions of a bishop. Hungarian Catholic leaders in the United States and elsewhere have to obtain his approval for their actions on or relating to Church matters.
